FLOORBALL ACT COVID-19 PROTOCOLS

as at 29 October 2021

WHAT'S ALLOWED?

- Vaccination strongly encouraged
- Competition permitted
 - Teams will not swap ends during games
 - Modified end-of-game formalities
- Full contact training permitted
- No more than one person per 4 m² present at any one time, up to a maximum of 100 people
- All participants, officials, and spectators must check-in using the Check In CBR app
 - Floorball ACT Committee members have the right to require proof of check-in
- All persons must obey physical distancing requirements and wear masks wherever possible off the court, particularly spectators

DO NOT ATTEND IF:

You are experiencing any of the following symptoms:

- Fever:
- Headache;
- Cough;
- Loss of taste/smell;
- Runny nose;
- Shortness of
- Sore throat;

breath;

or, you have travelled overseas, or to a COVID-19 hotspot, in the past two weeks;

or, you have been in contact with a suspected/confirmed COVID-19 case in the past two weeks.

WHAT'S NOT ALLOWED?

- No unnecessary social gatherings
- No spectators on team benches
- No hugs, high-fives, handshakes, etc.

"GET IN, PLAY/TRAIN, GET OUT"

HYGIENE REQUIREMENTS

- Floorball ACT will supply hand sanitiser, disinfectant wipes and spray for each session
- Wash or sanitize hands on entry, exit, after setup or pack-down, and regularly throughout session
- Do not share food, drink bottles, towels, or other equipment; do not drink from drink fountains
- Only the session coach/facilitator is to handle training aids (e.g. balls, cones, etc)
- Borrowed sticks should be sanitised before and after use
- Borrowed goalkeeper gear must be fully washed/sanitized between uses
- Any borrowed clothing/bibs to be immediately placed in separate bag for washing after use
- Minimize use of venue facilities wherever possible do not use showers, changerooms etc.
- Floorball ACT recommends a thorough full-body shower at home after every session

MULTI-SESSION EVENTS AT TUGGERANONG ARCHERY CLUB

- Players for next session to enter venue via main door, move to spectators' side of court
- After previous session's players leave, move all your belongings to players' side of court
- After the session, players are to sanitize their chair, and any borrowed equipment
- Players then exit the venue via the side door do not cross back over the court unless necessary

Failure to abide by Return to Play Protocols may result in disciplinary action.
