TEAM CONTRIBUTION POLICY

Introduction

Floorball ACT Inc. (Floorball ACT) is a purely volunteer-run organization. To that end, all teams participating in major internal Floorball ACT competitions are expected to provide assistance in the running of those competitions, including the provision of referees.

Purpose

The purpose of this policy is to outline the requirements of all teams in major internal Floorball ACT competitions with regards to:

- Providing assistance to the Floorball ACT Committee with the running of the competition; and,
- The provision of referees to the competition.

Policy

All teams entered into major internal Floorball ACT competitions must provide, at a minimum:

- At least one (1) player who is to be available to perform tasks as delegated by the Floorball ACT Committee; and,
- At least one (1) player must be available for referee duties at all times throughout the competition, as delegated by the Floorball ACT Director of Refereeing.

Players who already serve on the Floorball ACT Committee and/or already referee Floorball ACT games are counted towards the satisfaction of this Policy.

Teams must designate which player(s) will be made available to satisfy this Policy prior to the start of the competition. The player(s) designated may change during the competition; however, teams must provide players in satisfaction of this Policy at all times during the competition, save for reasonable absences of the player(s) designated.

Appropriate training for new referees will be arranged by the Floorball ACT Director of Refereeing.

Teams who fail to adhere to this Policy may be subject to sanctions, under the Regulations & Guidelines of the relevant competition.

At the discretion of the Floorball ACT Committee, exceptions to this policy may be made for particular teams.

Definitions

- 1. 'major internal competition' is a competition run by Floorball ACT for local members (as opposed to tournaments which include players/teams/clubs from interstate), involving games over a number of weeks (as opposed to 'one-off' tournaments). This includes:
 - a. Floorball ACT Summer Series;
 - b. Floorball ACT Winter Series; and,
 - **c.** Other similar competitions, as designated by the Floorball ACT Committee.
